Water Baptism

A. Definition

It is a ceremony, or rite which is biblically commanded and approved by the church to communicate what had happened to the person who had already repented and accepted Jesus as his Lord and saviour. It is not an ordinance that saves. By baptism, a believer identifies himself with the Lord Jesus in His death, burial and resurrection and through this ceremony he makes known his faith in Christ publicly.

B. The importance of water baptism

- 1. It pictures or symbolises spiritual cleansing. 1 Pet.3:18-22.

 It is an act of spiritual washing or cleansing of sins which was accompanied through Jesus Christ.
- 2. It pictures or symbolises the death of one's old life, his burial and resurrection to live a new life. Rom.6:1-11, Col.2:12, Eph.4:5 and Gal.3:27.

It is not the rite of water baptism but of work performed by God uniting us in Jesus so completely that His death and resurrection become our own.

We were buried therefore with Him by baptism into death, so that as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in the newness of life.

- 3. It is the command of the Lord Jesus. Mt.28:19-20.
- 4. It is a confirmation of the commitment to the Lord publicly. Mt.10:32.

C. What does baptize mean?

The Greek word for baptize is 'baptizo' which means to immerse or to dip someone or something into water.
